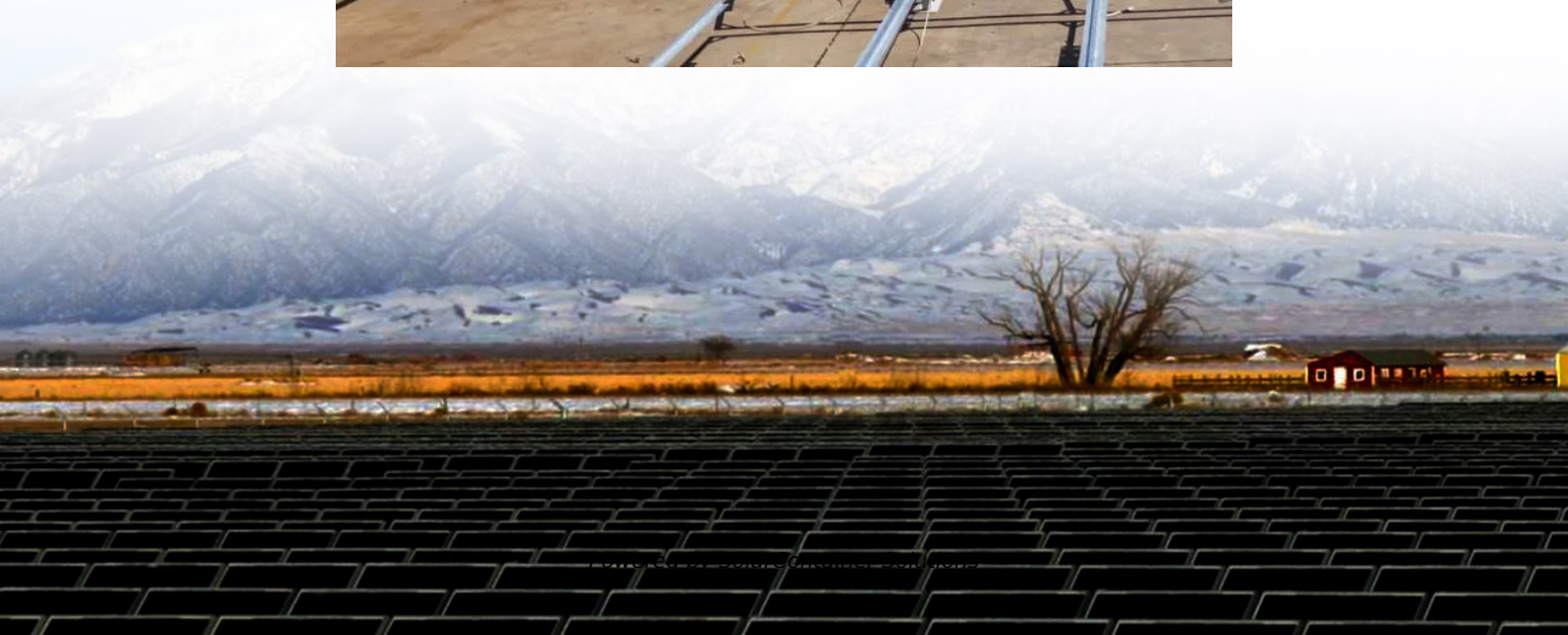


Brunei Telecom Container Wholesale





Overview

In 2023, ULAP Networks, a global cloud communications company, was awarded a Services-Based Operations (SeTi) license by the Authority for Information Communications Technology Industry (AITI). This license allows ULAP to offer telecommunications services including voice and cloud infrastructure within Brunei, supporting the country's digital transformation and connectivity goals.

What telcos does Brunei have?

IDD Country Code: +673 Brunei has 3 major telco namely DST, Imagine (TelBru) and Progresif which offers prepaid and postpaid plan. UNN is the Single Wholesale Network with holds all the telecommunication infrastructures in Brunei. Brunei 's Internet service was monopolized by Telekom Brunei.

What services does Brunei have?

Brunei possesses an extensive system of telecommunications, including telephone and mobile phone service, internet service, television and radio. The majority of Bruneians have access to these services: for every 100 Bruneians there are 118 mobile phone subscriptions, and 99% of the population uses the internet.

Does Brunei have a TV network?

The official radio and television network, Radio Television Brunei (RTB), operates five channels, and satellite systems make foreign broadcasts accessible as well. Telephone service throughout the country is excellent; international service is good to Southeast Asia, Middle East, Western Europe, and the US.

What will UNN's prefab data centre do for Brunei?

Upon construction completion, UNN's prefab data centre will have the capacity to host data centre and IT services and infrastructure of government and private businesses in Brunei. Together with other existing data centre locations of UNN in the country, the capacity and services can be provided in geo-redundancy.



How much does broadband cost in Brunei?

ADSL speeds were ranging from 512 kbit/s to the maximum speed of 1 Mbit/s through ADSL2+ broadband. 1 Mbit/s was introduced in 2006 and was priced at BND\$128 per month (Equivalent to Singapore currency). It was well known that the Brunei's broadband ranging from 512 kbit/s to 1 Mbit/s is one of the most expensive in the world.
