


Ethiopia exports energy storage







Overview

Despite its energy deficit, Ethiopia exports electricity to Djibouti, Sudan, and Kenya to generate foreign exchange. There is a plan to increase power exports up to 300 MW to Djibouti due to a growing dema.

Does Ethiopia export power to Kenya?

Ethiopia, through EEP, has a PPA to export up to 400 MW of power to Kenya. In May 2022, Ethiopia signed an MoU with South Sudan to export 100 MW of power over the next three years. Power Africa is a market-driven, U.S. Government-led public-private partnership that aims to double access to electricity in sub-Saharan Africa.

Does Ethiopia export power to Djibouti?

There is a plan to increase power exports up to 300 MW to Djibouti due to a growing demand. Ethiopia, through EEP, has a PPA to export up to 400 MW of power to Kenya. In May 2022, Ethiopia signed an MoU with South Sudan to export 100 MW of power over the next three years.

Why is the energy sector important in Ethiopia?

As energy is the backbone of industrial development, public investment has focused on developing the energy sector. In addition, to achieve its goal of increasing power generation capacity of Ethiopia four-fold by 2030, the government has called for the participation of the private sector.

How much electricity does Ethiopia use per capita?

On average, per capita electricity consumption remains low at less than 100 kWh per year, far below the average 500 kWh per capita energy consumption across African countries. The largest sources of energy consumption (about 87%) in Ethiopia remain traditional fuels. Demand for electricity is rapidly increasing in Ethiopia—by 30-35% annually.

Can Ethiopia supply a larger economy than today?

Ethiopia could supply a much larger economy than today in the AC, using only



twice the energy, were it to diversify its energy mix and implement efficiency standards. In the AC, this diversification comes about as a result of a substantial expansion of geothermal energy along with increased use of oil within industry and for cooking. IEA.

Will Ethiopia become an Eastern African Power Pool?

In addition, Ethiopia aims to become an Eastern African Power Pool and export power to Kenya, Sudan, Tanzania and Djibouti—more than doubling electricity exports (from 2,803 GWH to 7,184 GWH) by 2030. To address this large and growing demand, the government plans to significantly expand installed capacity.


